COVID HEALTH POLICY UPDATES

What will happen if...

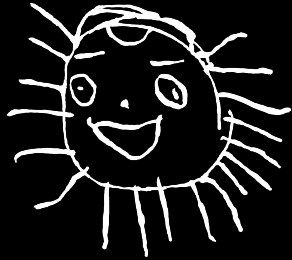
- A child, student or staff member has COVID-19 symptoms or has a temperature of 100 or above?
- A household member or someone in close contact with child, student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19?
- While a child, student or staff member has been isolated because of symptoms, **they receive a negative test result for COVID-19** and want to return to school, program before 10 days have passed?



COVID HEALTH POLICY UPDATES

What will happen if...

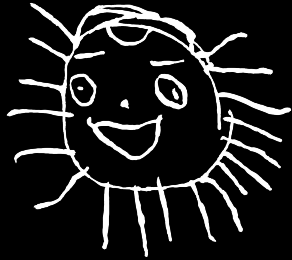
- Child, student or staff member has been isolated because of symptoms and want to return to school, program before 10 days have passed **without a COVID-19 test?**
- While a child, student or staff member is placed in quarantine following exposure to a case, they receive a negative test result for COVID-19?
- A child, student or staff member **tests positive for COVID-19?**

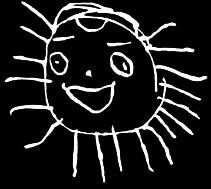
Communication Changes to Community Health Updates

1. Parent Access to up to date health information/symptoms of each class.
2. Direct community or class email of any COVID presumed cases or a positive test within the community

UNHEALTHY

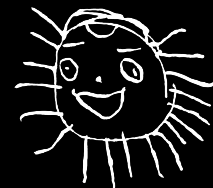
AQI of 151-200

Consecutive unhealthy
days may result in
school closure.

VERY UNHEALTHY AQI >200

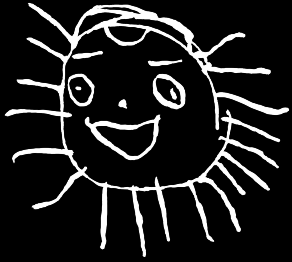
